

For over 25 years, Climate Solutions has been focused on mission-critical work at the state and local levels to accelerate clean energy solutions to the climate crisis, knowing that the progress we make here in the Pacific Northwest has an impact that goes far beyond our region: building deep and diverse partnerships, building power, and developing innovative new programs.

We cultivated new and powerful partnerships, and demonstrated our collective perseverance.

Three of the major levers for climate progress are scalable policies, private sector clean energy development, and people-powered action. This is Climate Solutions' key focus, and where Oregon and Washington are poised to continue leading.

We can't deny that the results of the US national elections will affect so many important issues in the upcoming years, and will also have a profound impact on many of our personal lives. And we know that the momentum for accelerating climate action is as real as the climate consequences already upon us.

You can feel proud of doing your part to make this region special and showing how our collective leadership here in the Pacific Northwest is critical in keeping our momentum going against the upcoming strong national headwinds.


Check out our progress this past year in these pages, and thank you for all that you do to drive regional climate leadership.

When communities get organized and work together for a healthier future, we can accomplish remarkable victories. Unfortunately, there are also those who want to block and attack our progress. We've seen both dynamics play out

in our region. In 2021, Washington communities came together to pass the "gold standard"

Climate Commitment Act, after Oregon communities rallied in support of strong climate policy, leading Governor Brown to direct, by executive order, the creation of the Climate Protection Program. Then came 2024. We knew that we'd have to defend the critical progress we've made—but would we have to fight in both states at the same time? Could we win?

Yes. And yes.



Communities and climate advocates in both states not only defended keystone climate policies, but collaborated to build some of the most expansive and diverse coalitions in our region's history. We worked together, and we achieved an incredible set of wins for climate progress in the Pacific Northwest:

Oregon climate leaders spent years trying to find a legislative path to a statewide plan to **continued on next page**



cut climate pollution. It eventually fell to the Department of Environmental Quality to design Oregon's Climate Protection Program (CPP), a program that would help the state clean up its biggest sources of pollution, improve our air quality, and create more clean energy jobs and resilience for communities. But after going into effect in 2022, the CPP was invalidated by a court in late 2023 after fossil fuel companies and gas utilities challenged the program on a technicality. That sent the state's DEQ back to the drawing board this year. Climate Solutions, alongside other climate advocates and

community organizations, worked to make sure that the agency would listen first to the public and not polluters. In November, the Environmental Quality Commissioners voted unanimously to reinstate a strong Climate Protection Program.

In Washington, thanks to the landmark Climate Commitment Act passed by the Legislature in 2021, the state can now hold polluters accountable for harming our air, water and climate. Major polluters now pay for their carbon emissions, creating a fund to support a wide range of emissions-cutting projects, including projects benefiting tribes and communities hardest hit by climate impacts.

These victories didn't sit well with the opponents of

climate progress. As part of an effort to weaponize the state's ballot initiative process to attack a range of progressive priorities, wealthy hedge fund manager Brian Heywood launched Initiative 2117, which would repeal major portions of the CCA and block the state from enacting any other carbon pricing mechanism.

But Heywood's efforts turned out to be no match for the robust and diverse coalition that emerged to protect the CCA. Climate Solutions and more than 600 groups worked together to oppose I-2117, including both large and small businesses, environmental groups, tribes, advocates for low-income and recent immigrant communities, unions, and more. People across the state mobilized to protect the community priorities threatened by I-2117, and in November voters rejected the bad initiative by a very wide margin.

As we approached Election Day in Washington we also suddenly faced yet another initiative—this one backed by building and gas industry interests as well as Heywood. Initiative 2066 aimed to repeal major portions of a new state law curtailing higher energy bills and smoothing the way for a gradual, orderly transition away from methane gas to clean energy. The backers of this initiative filed it late in the game—allowing clean energy advocates limited time to organize a response—and promoted it with a deceptive scare campaign.

However, despite a competitive disadvantage of time and money, Climate Solutions partnered with affordable housing experts, anti-poverty and hunger advocates, and others to inform voters about the dangers of 1-2066. Early polls projected that voters would overwhelmingly pass the confusingly-worded measure, but it passed by only a slim margin—a huge shift, and a significant testament to the power of our coalition. Climate Solutions and a number of partner groups ended the year by filing a lawsuit challenging I-2066 on constitutional grounds.



BROAD COALITIONS OF POWERFUL ALLIES

One hallmark of effective progress on climate and clean energy is that, when our victories are threatened by the fossil fuel industry and other special interests, a wide range of communities and organizations show up ready to defend them. Broad coalitions of powerful allies came together to oppose I-2066 in Washington, and to protect that state's Climate Commitment Act and Oregon's Climate Protection Program.

2024 was a year for the books for Climate Solutions' work in Washington. We fielded legislative policy campaigns, we engaged with state agencies, commissions and projects delivering concrete benefits to communities, and we fought for just outcomes in a heady election

season where it all got put to the test. We began the year with two ambitious campaigns to bring more zero-emissions buses to all Washington students and to begin addressing the enormous challenge of increasing access to clean energy to power our homes and buildings. Thanks to our coalition partners, legislative champions, and tireless grassroots advocacy, the end of a

This year was also the second in which the Climate Commitment Act program brought hundreds of millions of dollars in climate resilience and clean energy projects to communities across the state. The CCA's success has meant heat pumps installed in schools and multi-family

housing, new air quality monitoring sensors up and running, increased bike safety programs, EV charging infrastructure investments, EV rebates for people living on low incomes, weatherization and energy efficiency rebates, and much more.

Together we are seeing the immediate positive impacts and direct gains from one of the most ambitious climate programs in the country. Together we also rose up to defeat an enormous challenge to repeal the law this past election. We were part of the largest and most diverse coalition in our state's history. More than 600 endorsing organizations and

more than 2100 volunteers organized, texted, called, knocked, walked, emailed, and shouted from the rooftops to vote no on I-2117. We contacted voters in every county statewide, reaching more than 180,000 households. And we won by a large margin, demonstrating that Washington stands behind climate progress.

While our work to defend our climate laws and programs will continue in 2025, we are so proud of this year's incredible efforts that sent a resounding message to our fossil fuel and industry foes: Washington wants cleaner air, healthier communities, and strong climate policy that actually makes peoples'









Climate Solutions spent much of 2024 in the mode of defending climate progress victories already won. We did not yield, and were still able to help grow public programs that help people and take key steps to keep moving forward.

Our banner accomplishment for the year was our role in reinstating the Climate Protection Program (see *Defending Climate Progress*). But earlier in the year, we engaged with the Legislature to make sure that lawmakers

made new investments in popular state clean energy programs, including \$15 million for healthy homes and \$4 million in heat pumps, contributing to greater housing security for vulnerable

Oregonians. Legislators passed a handful of bills that address longer-term issues impacting Oregon's clean energy transition and start moving the needle on siting, energy markets, offshore wind, and divestment from coal.



Also this year, Oregon won a federal Climate Pollution Reduction Grant of \$200 million. These federal dollars will be administered by the state to tackle the largest contributors to Oregon's climate pollution: waste and materials, buildings, and transportation.

Our policy team continued to play a watchdog role, making sure there is no backsliding in our state climate goals. We engaged with coalition partners and the state agencies that implement and regulate different climate policies, including the Public Utility Commission, where we helped make sure commissioners voted to order gas subsidies to be phased out in compliance with state decarbonization goals. This is not only a climate victory, but a financial one for residential and business ratepayers who will no longer pay to subsidize gas expansions. We also made sure that the state now has the strongest possible Building Performance Standards for existing buildings in Oregon. The largest commercial buildings in our state, responsible for large amounts of pollution, will be required to clean up their act over time.

On transportation, we helped shape the newly created state rebate program to make zero emission medium and heavy duty vehicles more affordable, and supported the build out of charging infrastructure across the state. We defended attacks on the state's Advanced Clean Trucks program which sets standards for clean air and climate pollution controls.

We need more progress from the Legislature to protect Oregonians from climate extremes, and to ensure that everyone can afford clean energy solutions that save money and reduce fossil fuels.

A major part of our focus to achieve 100% clean energy has been to build enough renewable energy, storage, and transmission capacity to get power to where it is needed; we have focused on streamlining siting and permitting reform to help build out this capacity. We worked with rural communities to increase resilience with solar storage and micro grids. We also worked with large energy users and environmental justice partners on how to tackle barriers in power markets.

BREAKING BARRIERS ** **COLLABORATIVE**



Businesses accelerating equitable climate action



2024 was a year of tremendous growth and success for the Breaking Barriers Collaborative (BBC). We ran three cohorts - triple the previous year-of our Fleet Decarbonization Accelerator, a hands-on, cohort-based program that helps Pacific Northwest businesses and other organizations accelerate their transition to zero emissions vehicles. Participants represented a diverse group of organizations in Washington and Oregon: nonprofits like the Seattle Aguarium, large businesses such as Boeing and Skanska, educational institutions including Portland Community College and WSU, and municipal organizations such King County and Oregon Metro. Washington's Department of Commerce contracted with us to create and deliver a customized version of our Accelerator for more than a dozen Washington state agencies. Since our inception we've completed four Accelerators, with over 100 participants from 45 organizations representing more than 15,000 vehicles.

In addition to helping Accelerator participants transition their fleets, BBC aims to share graduates' progress with the broader business community to demonstrate the potential and businesses benefits of transitioning their fleets. This year we partnered with the Environmental Defense Fund to produce and promote a series of video case studies that highlight the progress

made by three Accelerator graduates: MTR-Western, City of Roses Disposal and Recycling, and DeSantis Landscapes.

All this progress has been made possible, in part, through the expanding number of partnerships we've developed over the past year. We continue to work closely with the Electrification Coalition to develop and deliver the Fleet Decarbonization Accelerators. We added several new sponsors including Puget Sound Clean Air Agency, Puget Sound Energy, and PGE. Our Community Partner Program continues to expand to more than ten organizations, with new additions including the Washington Trucking Associations and the Seattle Metropolitan Chamber of Commerce. These critical partnerships enable us to get our message out to new audiences and have helped us to recruit a diverse group of organizations to our programs.

Finally, in July we were awarded a grant from the Washington State Department of Ecology to develop an Electric School Bus Accelerator pilot for school districts planning to transition their school bus fleets. We're working in partnership with the Washington State University Green Energy Program and the Electrification Coalition to deliver this program in spring of 2025.




